Check out over 100 species of living arthropods!

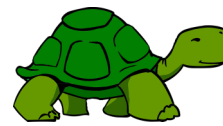
Insect Zoo staff will talk about the animals on display and help you handle millipedes, beetles, walking sticks, and more.


