Kids and families are encouraged to stop in, learn about, and play with the fun and engaging STEM games available for checkout at the library.

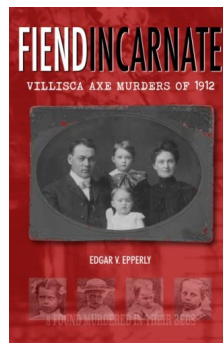


Fiend Incarnate: Villisca Axe Murders of 1912– Author Visit: Edgar V. Epperly

Author Dr. Edgar V. Epperly has been researching the 1912 Villisca axe murders for over 60 years.

He has written dozens of articles and blog entries, and appeared on CourtTV and other radio and television programs. He is a popular guest speaker at colleges, universities, historical societies, museums, libraries, and book stores. He resides in Decorah, Iowa. Epperly's research journey was the subject of the award-winning short documentary film AXMAN.
