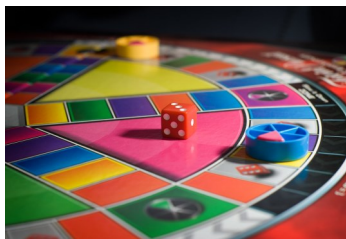
Movie Night:

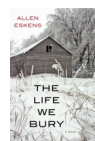
