

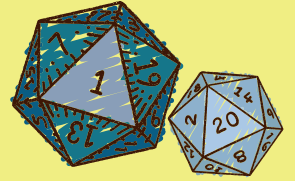


Teen Night:

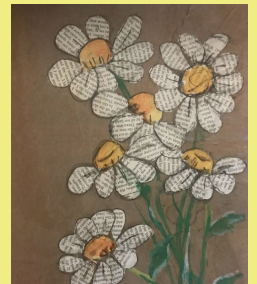
