Prisoners of War in Iowa-Linda Betsinger McCann:


Wednesday, May 11 at 3:00PM

Area author Linda McCann will discuss her book, *Prisoners of War in Iowa*.

Iowa had about 25,000 German, Italian, and Japanese prisoners of war from 1942 to 1946. Algona and Clarinda



were the main camps, each housing about 3,000 POWs. There were 19 branch around lowa, with



the prisoners
working on
short-term projects
such as working in
the fields, in canning
factories, or seed
corn companies.

Linda was able to speak with people who knew the prisoners and shares their memories.

She will have copies of all her books available for purchase after her presentation.
